

- Clean Treated area daily, allowing tepid water or shower to run over treated area. Do not pick, scratch or rub treated area.
- Apply a very thin layer of Elta MD Silver Gel to the treated area, as needed, for 3 days after treatment, or until the treated area has begun to crust over. Allow to heal as dry as possible for the first 3 days. After 3 days or when crusting begins to appear, apply Bacitracin or Neosporin antibiotic cream to the area, as needed, until healed.
- If it is necessary to cover the treated area, apply a Tefla pad until it is healed.
- If crusting occurs, do not shave or pick the treated area.
- No rubbing or scratching the treated area.
- Discomfort may be relieved by ice packs or Acetaminophen.
- No swimming or using hot tubs, Jacuzzis, steam rooms, or immersing the treated area in a hot bath until the treated area is healed.
- Small blistering is normal
- AVOID SUN EXPOSURE. Use Elta MD UV Physical Sunscreen DAILY if the treatment area will be exposed.

Over the course of 4-8 weeks after each treatment, specialized blood cells called macrophages will be attracted to the treated area. These macrophages will engulf the tiny particles of ink and remove them from the area. This means, during this time, the tattoo will gradually fade in preparation for either the next visit or completion of the treatment.
